The real highlight of Gulmarg is the iconic Gondola ride (at own cost), one of the highest cable cars in the world. As it ascends to Kongdori and further up to Apharwat Peak (14,000 ft), the breathtaking views of the mighty Himalayas leave visitors spellbound. In summer, the meadows come alive with rolling pastures, pony rides, and adventure sports, while winter transforms Gulmarg into a skier's paradise with pristine white slopes. Take a leisurely stroll, breathe in the crisp alpine air, or simply soak in the unparalleled beauty of this hill retreat. As the sun sets over the snow-clad peaks, retreat to your cozy hotel and embrace the tranquility of Gulmarg. Overnight stay in Gulmarg.

Day 3 Gulmarg-Pahalgam [150 Km] Overnight stay at Pahalgam

After a refreshing morning in Gulmarg, enjoy a scenic drive to Pahalgam (7,200 ft), the 'Valley of Shepherds,' one of the most breathtaking destinations in Kashmir. A favorite backdrop for Bollywood films, Pahalgam's charm lies in its lush meadows, pine-covered hills, and gushing Lidder River, creating a picture-perfect retreat. En route, soak in the mesmerizing views of the countryside, apple orchards, and saffron fields. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and prepare to be enchanted by Pahalgam's unspoiled beauty. This quaint town is also the gateway to the revered Amarnath Cave, making it a significant pilgrimage site. Adventure seekers can hire a local car (at own cost) to explore Aru Valley, Betab Valley, and Chandanwari, each offering postcard-perfect landscapes and a tranquil escape into nature. Alternatively, horse rides to Mini Switzerland, Baisaran, Dabyan, and Kashmir Valley provide a unique way to experience the breathtaking surroundings. As the sun dips behind the mountains, take a leisurely stroll through the local markets, sip on traditional Kahwa, and immerse yourself in the serene ambiance of Pahalgam. With its stunning vistas and peaceful aura, this valley is truly a slice of paradise. Overnight stay in Pahalgam.

Day 4 Pahalgam-Srinagar [120 Km] Srinagar sightseeing- Overnight stay at Srinagar

Wake up to the crisp mountain air of Pahalgam and enjoy a leisurely breakfast before embarking on a picturesque drive back to Srinagar. As you journey through winding roads lined with pine forests, apple orchards, and the meandering Lidder River, let the breathtaking scenery leave you spellbound. Upon arrival in Srinagar, step into the opulent world of Mughal gardens, a testament to timeless beauty and Persian-inspired landscapes. Begin with Nishat Bagh, the 'Garden of Pleasure,' built in 1633 by Asif Khan, offering cascading terraces of vibrant flowers, ancient Chinar trees, and stunning views of the Dal Lake. Next, immerse yourself in the romantic ambiance of Shalimar Bagh, the 'Garden of Love,' created in 1619 by Emperor Jahangir for his adored wife, Noor Jahan. Stroll through its symphony of fountains, lush greenery, and serene waterways, a setting that whispers tales of royal romance and poetic beauty. As the day unwinds, indulge in a Shikara ride on Dal Lake (if not done earlier), sipping on aromatic Kashmiri Kahwa while soaking in the sunset hues reflecting off the water. Let the tranquil charm of Srinagar captivate you before retreating to your hotel for a relaxing overnight stay. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 5 Srinagar-Sonmarg-Srinagar [90 Km] Overnight at Srinagar

Wake up to a refreshing Kashmiri morning and savor a delicious breakfast before setting off on a mesmerizing drive to Sonmarg, a paradise nestled at 2,740 meters above sea level. Known as the 'Meadow of Gold' and the 'Gateway to Ladakh', this enchanting valley is 86 km from Srinagar and is

As you approach Sonmarg, be prepared to be spellbound by its cinematic landscapes—where alpine flowers bloom in riotous colors, and glaciers glisten under the sun. For adventure seekers, a visit to the Thajiwas Glacier (at own cost), just 5 km from Sonmarg, is a must. You can choose to trek, ride a pony, or simply soak in the surreal beauty of this pristine icy wonderland. Sonmarg is also a gateway to some of Kashmir's most thrilling trekking routes and serves as an important base for the Amarnath Yatra via the Baltal Valley. Whether you choose to unwind by the Sindh River, enjoy a hot cup of Kahwa in a charming meadow, or simply admire the breathtaking Himalayan views, Sonmarg promises a day of pure magic. As the sun begins to set, drive back to Srinagar, reliving the day's adventures amidst the serene landscapes. Retire to your hotel for a peaceful overnight stay, carrying with you the golden hues of Sonmarg. Overnight stay in Srinagar.

Day 6 Srinagar-Departure

Wake up to the serene beauty of Srinagar one last time and enjoy a leisurely breakfast, savoring the flavors of Kashmir. Take in the final glimpses of the majestic mountains, tranquil lakes, and charming Mughal gardens before bidding farewell to this enchanting land.
