# Day 1 Arrival - Dimapur to Kohima (78 Kms / 03 Hrs)

Arrive at Dimapur Railway Station or Airport and transfer to Kohima, the capital of Nagaland. Upon arrival, check in to your hotel and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure, soaking in the unique atmosphere of the place. Overnight stay at Kohima.

# Day 2 Excursion to Khonoma Village and Kohima World War II **Cemetery**

After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to the Kohima War Cemetery, a memorial dedicated to the soldiers who made the ultimate sacrifice during World War II. This beautiful cemetery attracts visitors with its touching epitaphs and historical significance. Later, take an excursion to Khonoma Village, the first "green village" of Nagaland, located 21 kilometers from Kohima. Khonoma is famous for its vibrant culture and its association with the legendary leader Angami Zapu Phizo. The evening is free for leisure. Overnight stay at hotel.

### Day 3 Kohima to Dimapur (78 Kms / 03 Hrs)

After breakfast, depart for Dimapur, the economic capital of Nagaland and historically the capital of the Kachari kingdom. The city's name is derived from the Kachari dialect, and its history dates back to the age of the Mahabharata. In Dimapur, visit the Ruins of the Kachari Kingdom, which provide a glimpse into the ancient past. Spend the evening at the Dimapur Market, a bustling area where you can find goods imported from Myanmar and China. Overnight stay at hotel.

# Day 4 Dimapur - Departure

fter breakfast, check out from the hotel and head to Dimapur Railway Station or Dimapur Airport for your onward journey. Note: Inner Line Permit (ILP) is required for entry into Nagaland for Indian citizens of other states, except for Dimapur, which is exempt. Ensure you have the necessary documents for processing the permit.
