Sarnath, where Lord Buddha gave his first sermon after attaining enlightenment, is a place of immense spiritual importance, with its stupas, temples, and the Archaeological Museum reflecting the rich history of Buddhism in India. <br> The tour continues to Ayodhya, a city brimming with religious history, most notably associated with the birth of Lord Ram. Visiting sacred sites such as Sri Ram Janma-Bhoomi, the Kanak Mahal, and the Hanuman Garhi Temple will further deepen your connection to the divine. Ayodhya's spiritual aura, steeped in stories from the epic Ramayana, offers a tranquil and reflective end to your journey.

## Day 1

## Arrival at Varanasi

Upon your arrival at Varanasi Airport, you will be transferred to your hotel for check-in. In the evening, witness the mesmerizing Ganga Aarti at Dasaswamedh Ghat, a daily ritual that fills the air with the fragrance of sandalwood and the sounds of sacred chants and cymbals. The synchrony of the pandits' movements as they perform the aarti in front of the mighty Ganges is a sight to behold. After the ceremony, return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Varanasi.

## Day 2

## Varanasi Sightseeing

Start your day early with a visit to the Ganga Ghats for a holy dip in the sacred river. Afterward, embark on a temple tour to visit some of Varanasi's most famous temples, including Kashi Vishwanath Temple, Kaal Bhairav Temple, B.H.U., Sankat Mochan Temple, Tulsi Manas Mandir, and Tridev Temple. Later, enjoy breakfast at your hotel and relax before heading out for an afternoon road trip to Sarnath, where Lord Buddha gave his first sermon after attaining enlightenment. In Sarnath, you'll explore the Archaeological Museum, Buddha Temples, Stupas, and other historical landmarks. After sightseeing, return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Varanasi.

## Day 3

## Varanasi – Ayodhya

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and begin your journey to Ayodhya. Upon arrival in Ayodhya, check into your hotel and freshen up. In the afternoon, enjoy a sightseeing tour of Ayodhya, including visits to Sri Ram Janma-Bhoomi, the birthplace of Lord Ram, Dasarath Mahal, Kanak Mahal, and Hanuman Garhi Temple. After the tour, return to your hotel for an overnight stay in Ayodhya.

## Day 4

## Ayodhya – Departure

After breakfast, check out from your hotel and you will be escorted to Ayodhya Airport for your onward journey. Your tour ends with beautiful memories of the spiritual heartlands of India.
