Begin with a visit to the Bindabasini Temple, dedicated to Goddess Durga, where the 16thcentury architecture showcases Nepal's artistic heritage. Marvel at Davis Falls, an underground waterfall that vanishes into the earth, and explore the mysterious Gupteshwor Cave, a limestone marvel housing a shrine to Lord Shiva. Stand atop Mahendra Pul to witness the Seti Gorge, where the river flows in a hidden, mystical path through the city. In the evening, wander the lakeside area, savouring the city's serene charm.
