Day 1 ARRIVES AT COCHIN

Arrive in Cochin and transfer to your hotel. After freshening up, dive into the vibrant heritage of Cochin with a visit to Fort Cochin and Mattancherry. Marvel at the iconic Chinese fishing nets in action, then explore the historic St. Francis Church, where Vasco da Gama was once buried. Discover the beautiful Dutch Palace, home to ancient murals of Hindu epics, and stroll through the Jewish Street to the ornate Jewish Synagogue, built in 1568. Spend the night in Cochin, immersed in its rich culture and history.

Day 2 COCHIN to MUNNAR; 140KM, 4Hrs Drive

After a hearty breakfast, set off for Munnar, the famous hill station nestled in the Western Ghats (140 km, 4 hrs). Upon arrival, check into your hotel and unwind, then head out for a scenic tour. Visit Rajamalai, the natural habitat of the Nilgiri Tahr, perched 2695 meters above sea level. Explore the stunning beauty of the area until the evening, then return to your hotel for a restful overnight stay in Munnar.

Day 3 AT MUNNAR

After breakfast, embark on a full day of sightseeing in Munnar. Visit Mattupetty Dam, nestled at 1700 meters above sea level, offering picturesque views. Next, enjoy the serene Eco-Point and the tranquil Kundala Lake, perfect for relaxation and photography. Soak in the lush greenery and cool mountain air before heading back to your hotel for an overnight stay, reflecting on the beauty of this hill station.

Day 4 MUNNAR to THEKKADY; 110KM, 3.30 Hrs Drive

After breakfast, embark on a scenic drive to Thekkady (110 km, 3.5 hrs). Once you arrive, check into your hotel and relax. In the afternoon, immerse yourself in the fragrant spice plantations, where you'll discover the rich aromas of Kerala's spices. Later, enjoy a serene boating experience in Periyar Lake, surrounded by lush forests and wildlife. Spend the night in Thekkady, where nature's beauty comes alive.

Day 5 THEKKADY to ALLEPPEY; 180KM, 4.5Hrs Drive

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and drive to Alleppey (180 km, 4.5 hrs). Upon arrival, check into a luxurious houseboat and enjoy an unforgettable overnight cruise. Drift along the tranquil backwaters, meandering through narrow canals and picturesque villages. Relish authentic local food on board while soaking in the beauty of Kerala's traditional country life. The peaceful sail offers a glimpse into the region's unique charm, making this a highlight of your journey.

Day 6 ALLEPPEY to KOVALAM; 190KM, 4.30Hrs Drive

After a delightful breakfast, check out from the houseboat and drive to Kovalam (190 km, 4.5 hrs). Upon arrival, check into your beachside resort and unwind. Spend the evening enjoying beach activities, whether it's a swim in the Arabian Sea or relaxing on the golden sands. The coastal vibes will leave you rejuvenated. Overnight at Kovalam, where the sun, sea, and sand create the perfect end to your Kerala journey.

Day 7 DROP AT TRIVANDRUM

After a hearty breakfast, check out from the hotel and head to Trivandrum. Start your cultural exploration with a visit to the Kuthiramalika Palace Museum, followed by a trip to the Napier Museum and the nearby zoo. Don't miss the Raja Ravi Varma Art Gallery to witness some of India's finest artwork. In the evening, you'll be dropped off at the Trivandrum Airport or Railway Station, taking home memories of Kerala's rich heritage and beauty.
