### Day 1 PHNOM PENH, SOUR SDEY “HELLO” CAMBODIA

Upon arrival at Phnom Penh International Airport, you'll go through the immigration process (visa on arrival is available or can be obtained in advance via [www.evisa.gov.kh](http://www.evisa.gov.kh)). After collecting your luggage, proceed to the exit gate where our driver (without a guide) will be waiting for you. You'll be transferred to your hotel, approximately 45 minutes away, for check-in (check-in time is at 2:00 PM). Take some time to freshen up and relax at the hotel. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

### Day 2 PHNOM PENH'S PAST & PRESENT

After breakfast, start your exploration with a visit to the Royal Palace, a magnificent Khmer-style complex built in 1866 by the ancestors of King Norodom. Adjacent to the palace, visit the Silver Pagoda, home to the Emerald Buddha and various statues crafted from diamond, emerald, gold, and silver. Continue to the National Museum, an architectural masterpiece dating back to 1917, showcasing over 5,000 ancient Khmer artifacts made from sandstone, bronze, silver, and wood. Next, visit the Independence Monument, erected in 1954 to commemorate Cambodia's independence from French colonial rule. Learn about Cambodia's darker past with a visit to the Toul Sleng Genocide Museum (S21), a former school that was transformed into a prison and torture center during the Khmer Rouge regime. Then, head to Phsar Thmey (Central Market), a 1937 landmark built in the shape of a dome with sprawling wings filled with a variety of goods, from jewelry to local produce. Finally, visit Wat Phnom, a Buddhist temple perched on a hill that gives Phnom Penh its name. The temple holds historical significance and is a popular spot for locals to pray for good fortune or enjoy the scenic views at sunset. Overnight in Phnom Penh.

### Day 3 PHNOM PENH – SIEM REAP

After breakfast, travel by road to Siem Reap (without a guide). En route, experience the daily life of Cambodians as you pass through picturesque provincial towns and villages, often slowing down to let cows and water buffalo cross the road, or to pass horse-drawn carts and school children cycling to class. Consider stopping at Skoun, famously known as "Spiderville," where you can try the local delicacy of deep-fried tarantula. Another stop might be in Kompong Kdei to see the ancient Spean Pratos bridge, a stunning example of Angkorian architecture. Overnight in Siem Reap.

### Day 4 ANGKOR HIGHLIGHTS

After breakfast, begin your exploration of Angkor, starting with the stunning Angkor Thom, a walled city and masterpiece of King Jayavarman VII. At the heart of Angkor Thom, visit Bayon Temple, known for its 54 towers adorned with smiling faces of the Bodhisattva Avalokiteshvara. Next, visit the Terrace of the Leper King and Terrace of Elephants, once used by the king to oversee parades and public events. Continue to Baphuon, an imposing temple dating back to the 11th century, known for its beautiful architecture and intricate carvings. Next, head to Ta Prohm, a hauntingly beautiful temple that has been overtaken by the jungle, with massive tree roots entwined around the stone structures. Finally, visit Angkor Wat, the largest religious monument in the world, a symbol of Cambodia and a testament to the genius of ancient Khmer architecture. Overnight in Siem Reap.

### Day 5 SIEM REAP DEPARTURE

Enjoy a relaxing boat ride on Tonle Sap Lake, the largest freshwater lake in Southeast Asia. Here, you will visit the floating village, where people live in houses that float on the lake, moving with the changing water levels. You'll also visit Artisans d'Angkor, an organization dedicated to preserving ancient Khmer arts and crafts while providing employment opportunities for rural artisans. Afterward, transfer to Siem Reap airport for your departure to the next destination. It's time to say goodbye, and we thank you for traveling with us. We hope to welcome you again in the future. Inclusion: Transfers, Guide, Entrance Fees, Boat Ride, Breakfast.

## CANCELLATION/NO SHOW POLICY

- The date of cancellation will be the date we have your final notification.
- If you cancel our contract any time to 45 days prior to your departure: No charge
- If you cancel our contract 44 to 30 days prior to your departure: you will have to pay 50% of total tour cost
- If you cancel our contract 29 to 0 (zero) days prior to your departure: you will have to pay 100% of total tour cost
- Child under 3 (sharing the same bed with parent): Free of charge
- Child from 3-5 years old: 50% price of adult in case sharing the same bed with parent and 75% price of adult in case using an extra bed
- Child from 6-10 years old: 75% price of adult in case sharing the same bed with parent and 100% price of adult in case using an extra bed
- Child from 11 years old: counted as adult and will have an extra bed

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Passport, sun block, sunglasses & hat, insect repellent, small VND notes for buying drinks. Please note that you are responsible for your personal belongings, we are not responsible for any loss or damage happening during the tour with us.
- Tips are compulsory 3\$ per person per day, please pay this to the guide directly.
- The private transfer on tours for your own group and not shared with others, but is limited to predetermined routes and adhering to specified time slots as agreed upon in the itinerary. This means that although you will have a private transfer, you won't have the freedom to deviate from the planned routes or make unscheduled stops. Instead, you will need to follow the designated itinerary and adhere to the agreed-upon schedule, otherwise surcharge will be applied.
- Airport transfer time: Due to the traffic situation, we will need 2.5 hours for domestic flight and 3.5 hours for the international one.
- If you have any allergies, special requests or if you are on a special diet please let us know well beforehand, we can not cancel / amend the booking within a day.
- There is no refund or exchange that can be made for unused services not utilized by your tour member or due to your late arrival without proper notice well in advance.
- Check-in time of hotel is normally after 14:00 and check out time before 12:00 pm Notes: Hotel/cruise can be changed to a similar standard, depending on the availability
- If your flight is delayed or changed, please PHONE your travel consultant in charge of your booking (mobile phone) as soon as you have this news from the airlines so that we can adjust the pickup as well as other services accordingly. If you inform us late and we can not change the services for you, you will have to pay for all the extra services such as the extra pick up.
- Should you wish to change the site to visit or other activities, please inform us a day before. Please kindly note that changes can be yes or no, depending on lots of factors. And if yes, extra charges can be applied to changes (extra time, extra activities, different services), e.g tour guide and driver working more than the confirmed hours or we have to use different transfers or different routes.
- We suggest you to leave on time everyday so that it won't affect to the sites to see and other activities afterward, if you leave later than the written time; you will certainly have a shorter visiting time., you will have to cut some of the sightseeing places., you may have to pay extra.
- Please note that we will stick to the agreed time written above, any changes to the departure times or finishing times must be informed to us the day before departure and we will confirm if these changes are possible.
