Steeped in history and mythology, Ayodhya is a significant pilgrimage site for Hindus. Here, you can visit the iconic Ram Mandir and explore other landmarks like Kanak Bhawan and Hanuman Garhi. Ayodhya's rich religious history, as narrated in the Ramayana, comes alive at locations such as Guptar Ghat, where Lord Rama is believed to have taken Jal Samadhi. Bharat Khud and Makhuda Dham further amplify the city's connection to the epic tale of Lord Rama's life. End your day with a visit to the Swami Narayan Mandir for a peaceful, reflective experience. This tour is a unique opportunity to experience India's ancient spiritual essence, offering an unforgettable journey through two of the country's most sacred cities, Varanasi and Ayodhya. Whether you're seeking divine blessings or wishing to explore the depth of India's cultural heritage, this trip promises to leave you spiritually enriched and deeply connected to India's profound traditions.

## Day 1 Arrivals at Varanasi – Sightseeing

Upon your arrival at Varanasi Airport or Railway Station, our representatives will meet and greet you. You will then be transferred to your pre-booked hotel for check-in. After a short refreshment break, head to Dashashwamedh Ghat in the evening to witness the mesmerizing Ganga Aarti, where lamps are offered in praise of the Ganges, regarded as a goddess in Hinduism. You can experience this sacred ceremony from the ghat or enjoy it on a boat ride (optional, direct payment). Afterward, return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Varanasi.

## Day 2 Varanasi Sightseeing

Start your day early at 5 AM with a visit to the Old Kashi Vishwanath Temple, Annapurna Temple, and Vishalakshi Temple, which are all part of the same complex. Continue your spiritual journey with a visit to Kal Bhairav Temple. Afterward, return to the hotel for breakfast. Later, embark on an excursion to Sarnath, where Lord Buddha delivered his first sermon after attaining enlightenment. Explore the impressive Mulagandhakuti Vihara, Sarnath Museum, Chaukhandi Stupa, Dhamekh Stupa, Dharmarajika Stupa, and the famous Sarang Nath Temple. In the evening, visit Birla Mandir (New Kashi Vishwanath Temple), Sankat Mochan Mandir, Durga Temple, Tulsi Manas Mandir, and Bharat Mata Mandir. Return to the hotel for a peaceful overnight stay.

## Day 3 Varanasi - Ayodhya

After breakfast, drive to Ayodhya, an ancient city revered as the birthplace of Lord Rama. Upon arrival, visit the iconic Kanak Bhawan, Hanuman Garhi, Ram Mandir, and Dasrath Mahal. In the evening, enjoy the light show at Surajkund, which brings the historical grandeur of Ayodhya to life. After the show, return to the hotel for an overnight stay in Ayodhya.

## Day 4 Ayodhya Sightseeing

After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to Guptar Ghat, where it is believed that Lord Rama performed Jal Samadhi. Continue to Bharat Khud, the site where King Bharat stayed for 14 years during Lord Rama's exile. Visit Makhuda Dham, where King Dashrath performed a Yajna for the birth of his sons. Finally, visit Swami Narayan Mandir before returning to the hotel for a relaxing overnight stay.

## Day 5 Ayodhya Departure

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. You will be dropped at Ayodhya Airport or Railway Station for your onward journey, leaving with cherished memories of your spiritual journey through the holy cities of Varanasi and Ayodhya.
