Then, head to the Dro-dul Chorten and its peaceful surroundings, a stupa with a rich history and spiritual significance. No visit to Gangtok is complete without a stop at the Banjakhri Falls. Feel the cool mist of the waterfall as it cascades down surrounded by lush greenery, creating a perfect spot to relax and connect with nature. Day 6 Gangtok – NJP Rly Station / IXB Airport (120 kms / 5 hrs)
