Explore the stunning landscape before returning to your hotel for an overnight stay, soaking in the cool mountain air of Munnar.

Day 3 Munnar

After a delicious breakfast, get ready for a day of exploration in Munnar! Start with a visit to Mattupetty Dam, located 1,700 meters above sea level, offering stunning views of the surrounding hills and tranquil waters. Next, head to Eco-Point, a picturesque spot known for its panoramic vistas and cool, refreshing breeze. Continue your journey to Kundala Lake, where you can unwind by the peaceful waters or take in the breathtaking surroundings. After a day filled with nature's beauty, return to your hotel for a relaxing overnight stay in Munnar.

Day 4 Munnar to Thekkady

After a hearty breakfast, check out from Munnar and set off on a scenic 3.5-hour drive to Thekkady, located 110 km away. Upon arrival, check into your hotel and take a moment to refresh. In the afternoon, immerse yourself in the aromatic world of Thekkady's spice plantations, where you'll explore the vibrant fields of cardamom, pepper, and other exotic spices. Afterward, enjoy the serene beauty of Periyar Lake with an optional boat ride, where you may spot wildlife along the shores. As the day winds down, return to your hotel for a peaceful overnight stay in the tranquil surroundings of Thekkady.

Day 5 Thekkady to Alleppey

After a relaxing breakfast, check out from your hotel and embark on a scenic drive to Alleppey, known for its tranquil backwaters. Upon arrival at the houseboat jetty, check-in to your houseboat at 12 Noon, where an unforgettable experience awaits. As you set sail through the peaceful backwaters, glide through narrow canals, picturesque villages, and lush greenery. The houseboat provides a unique vantage point of Kerala's traditional country life, offering a window into the serene lifestyle of the locals. Enjoy a delicious meal on board as you drift through the scenic waterways. The evening is yours to unwind and soak in the natural beauty that surrounds you, before enjoying an overnight stay on the houseboat, lulled by the gentle sway of the waters.
