Explore the Maiden Tower and the Palace of the Shirvanshahs while learning about Baku's rich history. Enjoy dinner at an Indian restaurant before returning to the hotel for a relaxing evening.

Day 4 Gobustan + Shopping Tour

On this day, you will venture out to Gobustan, home to ancient rock petroglyphs that date back to the 12th century BC. This UNESCO World Heritage site offers a glimpse into early human history through its stunning rock engravings. Afterward, you will visit the Bibi-Heybat Mosque, an important historical site. In the afternoon, the tour shifts to a shopping spree, with visits to local sweet shops, Aliahmad's Azerbaijan brand store, and a variety of shops selling dry fruits and sweets. You will also have the opportunity to explore Genclik Mall, the largest mall in Baku, which offers a wide range of shopping and entertainment options. Dinner will be at a local restaurant, and the evening is free to explore at your leisure.

Day 5 Day at Leisure + Departure

On your final day in Baku, enjoy a day at leisure to explore the city or relax before your journey home. After lunch, you will check out from the hotel and be transferred to the airport for your flight, marking the end of your unforgettable trip to Baku.
